15. PUBLIC SPACE PROTECTION

The Environmental Protection Officer has released the new Public Space Protection Order in relation to dog control which is now in place (replacing the existing dog control order). The legislation dictates that signage should be erected covering the area concerned and as this is a District wide order, it has been decided in the first instance to concentrate on areas such as play areas and sports pitches. Councillors are invited to consider and decide how many signs the Clerk should order. (NB: District Council are covering the cost)
