### RED PHONE BOX

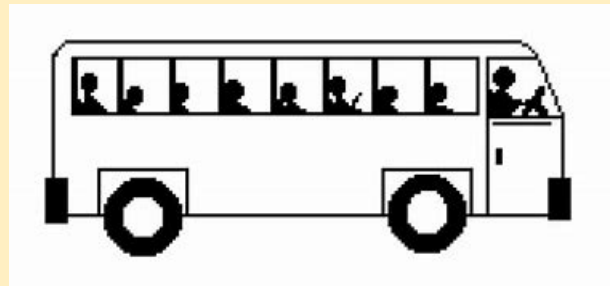
The Council would like to replace the old phone box on Newton Burgoland Main Street, with a more traditional red phone box.
